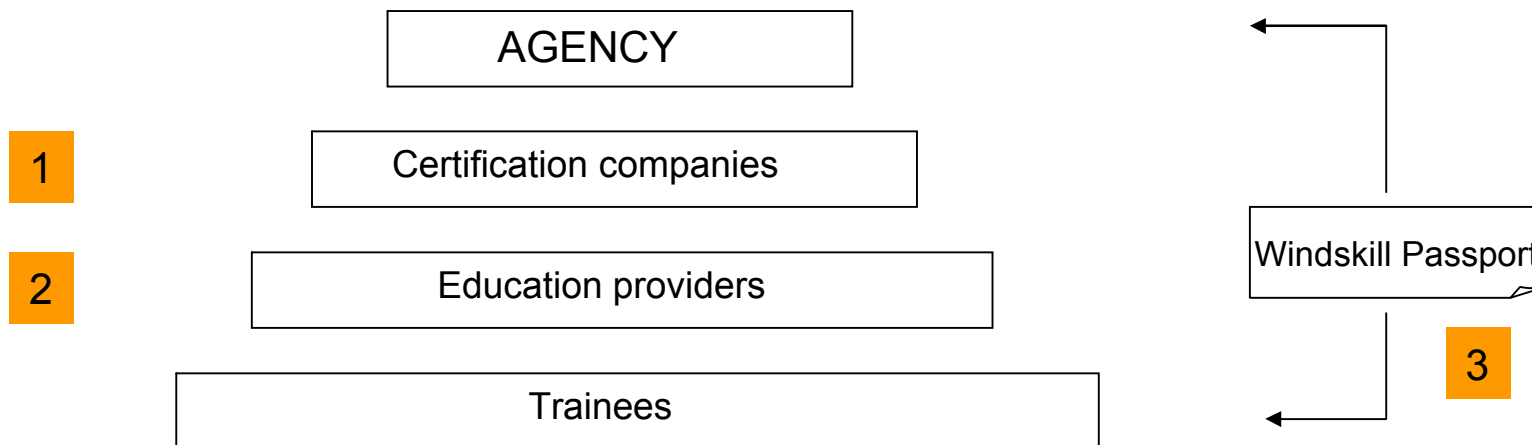
Mission

- ▶ Promote the Standard internationally

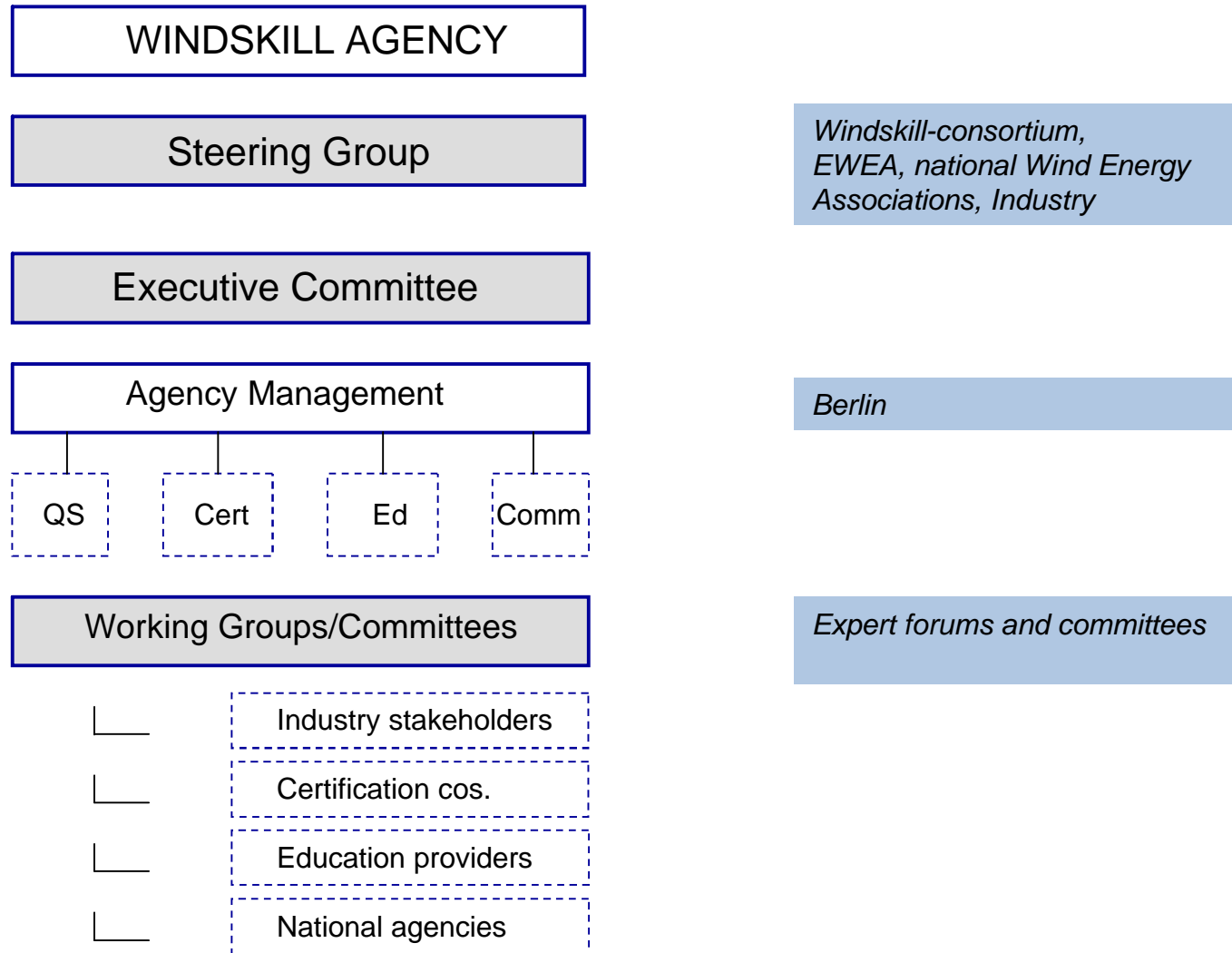
INDUSTRY SHAPES ITS QUALIFICATION STANDARD

 3. Administration of the Windskill Passport

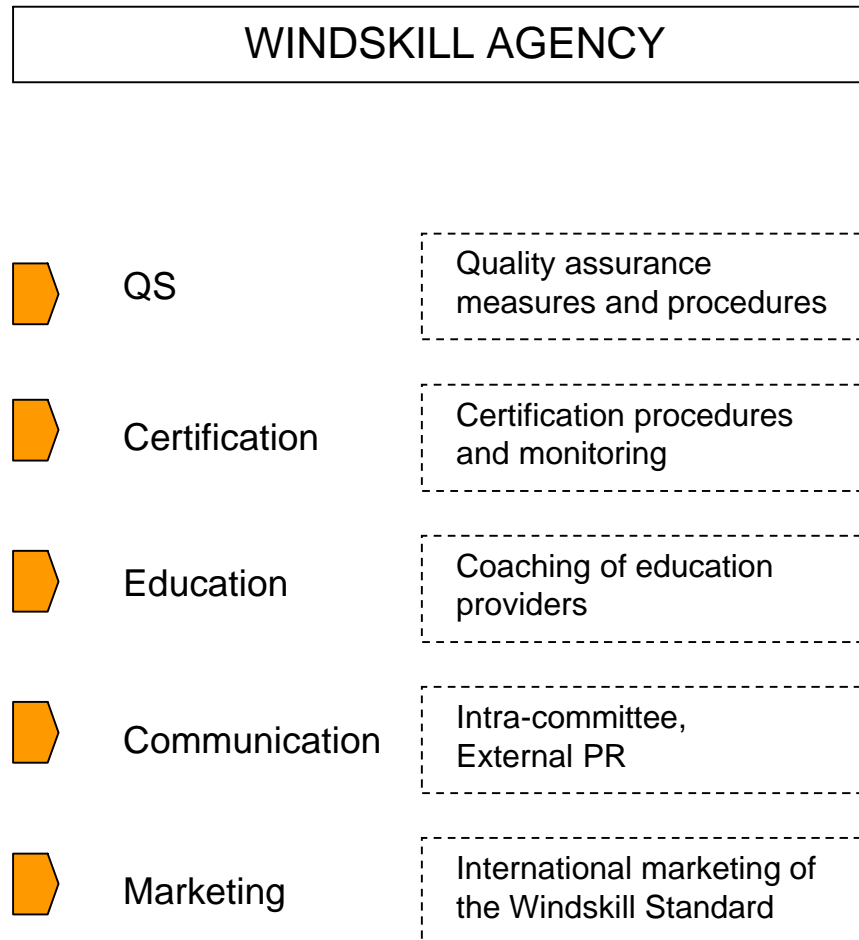

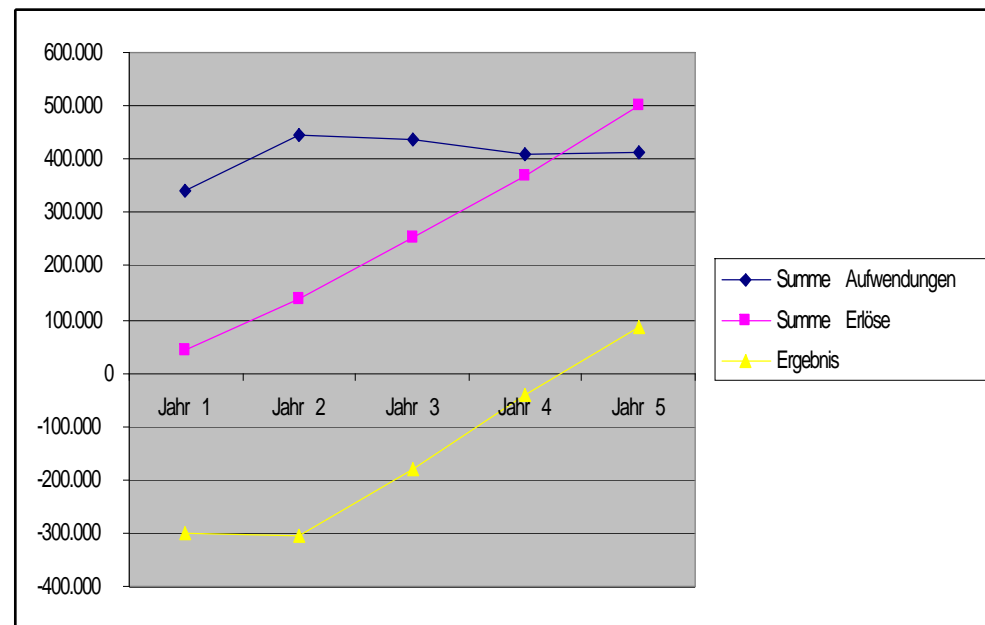
